Prom Parking Fundraiser

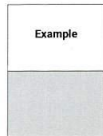

You may purchase an individual ticket for \$2 or 3 tickets for \$5.

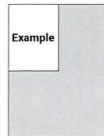
When you win, Mr. Kotik or Ms. Ferretti will meet you at the west doors to let you in each day. Times will be coordinated with each winner.

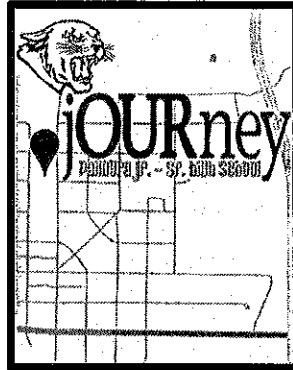
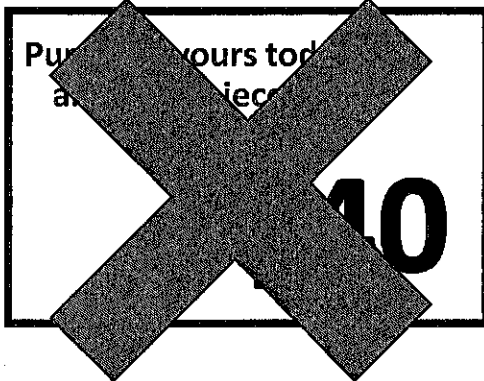
